Description

The Dynamic Learning Agenda is a tool designed to track progress on short term learning goals without losing sight of the overall project objective. Project participants are asked to rephrase potential issues in terms of a question to be answered, and progress on answering these questions is reflected upon at subsequent meetings. Learning questions on the agenda may change in order of importance, be removed or added to as the project develops and new challenges are identified, ensuring that learning goals remain relevant to the project's objective.

- Monitors learning progress
- Facilitates the acquisition of new knowledge and skills
